
English

Reading

- Know how to decode words using sounding out and blending.
- Know how to read some Year 1 common exception words.
- Know the sequence of events in a story and be able to talk about them



Writing

- Know how to use adjectives and a wider range of vocabulary when writing sentences.
- Know and use letter names to distinguish between alternative spellings of the same sound.
- Know how to use adjectives to describe a character in a well known story.
- Be able to write an acrostic poem.

Science

- Know and name a variety of common wild and garden plants and trees.
- Know and name the petals, stem, leaves and root of a plant.
- Know and name the roots, trunk, branches and leaves of a tree.
- Collect and record plant samples from the local area.

Additional vocabulary: soil, flowers, seeds, deciduous and evergreen.

RE

- Talk about signs that Easter is coming
- Understand what happened at key points in the Easter story
- Talk about what emotions different parts of the Easter story shows
- Understand the different ways Christians remember Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

Additional vocabulary: Maundy Thursday

History

- Find out about Mary Anning and explain why she is famous.
- Use **artefacts**, pictures, stories, online sources and databases to find out about the past.
- Find out about the fossils Mary Anning is most famous for discovering?
- Describe significant historical events that impacted the lives of dinosaurs.

Additional vocabulary: Jurassic Period, carnivore, herbivore, omnivore and extinct.

Music

- Identifying sounds, changes in pitch, matching instruments to sound.
- Consider timbre, dynamics & tempo, explore pitch and order sounds.
- When performing, use dynamics, pulse & tempo, percussion, graphic score, and follow a conductor.

PE

- Explore travelling movements.
- Develop stability and control when performing balances.
- Develop technique and control when performing shape jumps.
- Develop technique in the barrel, straight and forward roll. To link gymnastic actions to create a sequence.

Maths

Year 1

- Partition into tens and ones.
- Know the numberline to 50.
- Find doubles and use near doubles.
- Subtract by finding the difference.
- Measure lengths in cm.
- Measure and compare mass and volume

Year 2

- Learn and practice 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables and know the corresponding division facts.
- Learn multiplication through equal groups.
- Count and draw arrays to solve multiplication questions.
- Revise doubles and halves.
- Learning division through sharing and grouping.
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division.
- Measure in cm and m; g and kg; ml and l.

DT

- Know how to **weigh** ingredients to use in a **recipe**
- Know what ingredients are used when making a fruit salad
- Know how to explain what went well with their work
- Know how and why we cut food safely

Computing

- Know that all objects have a label.
- Describe and count objects in different ways.
- Compare groups of objects
- Answer questions about groups of objects.
- Know how to record and share information.
